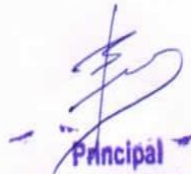

The institution has initiated several measures in gender equity & sensitization in curricular can be seen from the courses introduced by the institution. For example, the Department of Sociology offers two courses on 'Contemporary Issues of women in India' and 'Women and Society in India'; the Department of English offers two courses on 'Representation of Gender & Sexuality in Literature' and 'Women's Writing in India'; The department of Economics two courses which have alimnt that focus on the "Problems and Policy of Female Workers in India" (under the course 'Labour Economics') and "Gandhian perspective on the status of women" (under the course 'Gandhian Economic Thought')

Our institution believes that for the post of Peon is not only for a male class but also a women can perform the responsibility well and keeping this aim in view women employees are working for Peon post in our college accordingly women and men are shown equal spirit that is Gender Equality.

The institution promotes gender sensitization through co-curricular activities like workshops, seminars, guest lectures, street plays, poster exhibitions, counselling etc. The institution organized 'Self-defense training' for the girl students of the institution initiated by the Police Department. Awareness programs like importance of human rights, Rights of Women in Domestic problems, Cyber security awareness programs related to the safety and security of women employees and students are conducted periodically. Department of Sociology conducted 'Gender Equality' to figure out the opinion of students on gender equality and to come up with possible solutions if any rights are violated. Based on the outcome of the survey conducted on campus, the institution with pride declares that 'We are gender neutral educational institute'.

The institution constituted the following committees as per norms laid by University/UGC: Institution Grievance Redressal Committee, Anti-Ragging, Sexual harassment prevention cell, Students' Disciplinary Committee, Women Welfare & SC /ST Students Welfare Committee, Safety & Disaster Management Committee and Mentoring Programme cares for the well-being of students and staff in the institution. The functions of these committees are displayed on the website of the institution and information is being disseminated to the students through orientation and induction programs.

The institution provides safety and security facilities for the staffs and students such as CCTV Surveillance throughout the campus and security arrangement. Students wear ID cards at all times and outsiders are checked by security staff before allotting visitor IDs. The institution has a dedicated Counselling Centre and good mentoring system for the students to take care of their academic, emotional, social and cognitive development. Personal Counselling is provided to the students at different levels. There are separate washroom facilities for girls and boys. At our institution we have started Pink Room facility for Girls where they can relax when they feel uncomfortable. A washroom has also been arranged by adding it sanitary napkin vending and disposal machine for the safe and hygienic disposal of sanitary napkins.
